## Ewelina Flinta - Biography

Ewelina Flinta is one of the most popular Polish singers. She started her career as a fifteen-year-old girl. She made her stage debut with her band "Surprise" on the Woodstock Festival in 1997. In 2002 she was second in the Polish edition of "Idol". Since then, the speed of her career has been breathtaking. In 2003 she released her first album "Przeznaczenie" (transl. "Destiny") which got the Gold status, and in 2005 "Nie znasz mnie" (trans. "You don't know me").

Her hits such as: "Żaluję" (transl. "I regret")

"Goniąc za cieniem" (transl. "Running after shadow")

"Nie znasz mnie" (transl. "You don't know me")

"Nieskończona historia" (transl. "Endless history")

"Bliżej" (transl. "Closer")

were on the top of the pop charts for months.

In 2009, Ewelina as a soloist came back on the Woodstock stage. In the company of many well-known Polish singers, she performed on the jubilee concert on the occasion of the 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Woodstock Festival 1969. She sang "Cry baby" by Janis Joplin. Her interpretation of the song has met with warm approval from the audience and critics. When the organizer of legendary Woodstock'69 Michael Lang was asked about the impressions from the over 20-hour concert, he said that the performance of Ewelina was especially touching.

She is the winner of many contests, such as:

*Superjedyńka* in the category of "The Best Singer of the Year"- 2004& 2005

*Superjedyńka* in the category of "The Best Hit of the Year"- 2008

(*Superjedyńka* is the prize which the viewers of Polish TV award Polish singers for their achievements in the field of music for the last 12 months.)

*Róża Galii* (transl. Gala's Rose) for the most beautiful debut- 2003

(*Gala* is one of the most widely-read Polish weekly magazine for women.)

*All-Poland Radio Eska's Award* in the category of "The Best Singer of the Year"-2003

What is more on the prestigious Festival of Polish Video Clips –Yach Film 2008, she received the award for the best video clip to the song "Nie kłam, że kochasz mnie" (transl. "Don't lie that you love me").

The international audience met her during Baltic Song Contest in Karlsham. For the first time in 2004 with the song "Żaluję", and again in 2008, when she sang "Nie kłam, że kochasz mnie"

together with Łukasz Zagrobelny (Polish singer). The singers were third in this contest and received the Audience Award.

Apart from the stage activity, she also works for charity. She supports many foundations, for example: Foundation "[Mam marzenie](#)" (transl. "I have a dream") and Foundation "[Mimo wszystko](#)" (transl. "Despite everything") which is led by Anna Dymna. Ewelina Flinta also supports some undertakings connected with ecology such as: Club "[Światoczułych](#)" (transl. "Worldsensitive") and Foundation "[Nasza Ziemia](#)" (transl. "Our Planet").

At present, the singer is giving concerts, and is working on a new album.
